

# **CHRIST CHURCH VIDYAPITH, KODUKULANJI**

## **ANNUAL REPORT 2022-23**

Honourable Chief Guest Prof. Joseph Thomas, Manager of Self Financing Schools, CSI Madhya Kerala Diocese, Kottayam, Rev. Nebu Skariah, Local Manager, Prof. Samuel K Samuel, Director of Academics and Bursar, PTA President & other office bearers, invited guests, Parents, Teachers and dear Students

At the very outset, we the Christ Church Vidyapith family thank our Almighty God for the blessing he has showered upon this institution during this academic year which is still in progress.

We are celebrating the annual day after 2 years. Our school functioned as a First Line treatment centre in 2020 and as domiciliary care centre in 2021 and was a blessing to the Covid patients who were in isolation.

It is my honour to present before you the 24<sup>th</sup> annual report of Christ Church Vidyapith, Kodukulanji, owned and run by Christ Church Educational & Charitable Society of CSI Madhya Kerala Diocese. The school is affiliated to CBSE. It is situated in a serene location and has all the necessary infrastructure facility, well equipped laboratory, spacious library and a vast playground. We have classes starting from play class to class X. The first five batches of STD X passed CBSE Board Exam with flying colours. We have at present Dance, Art, Yoga, Karate and Physical Education classes. Our students produced 100% results for class X public examination, 2021-22 with two students scoring above 90%, 8 distinctions and 6 first classes.

We have a total of 431 Students, 28 teachers, a Principal, Vice Principal, 2 Clerical Staff, 4 Drivers, 5 Ayaahs and a Security. Four buses ply for the transportation of students.

This year Prof. Samuel K Samuel, Retired Principal Crossland College Brahmavar, Manglore joined our school as Director of Academics and Bursar replacing Mr. Regi Kuruvilla who opted out due to personal reasons. He guided us during the last 2 years. He showed keen interest in the overall development of the school. He set up a prayer room in the school. To comply with the requisites for extension of affiliation, we needed fire and safety certificate and sufficient number of washrooms. These requirements were fulfilled during his tenure. He introduced a salary scale for the staff and was instrumental in giving a facelift to the school. I place on record our gratitude to Mr. Regi Kuruvilla for all his contributions to the growth of our school.

Each day begins with a staff prayer and prayer conducted by students. Assembly is conducted twice a week by students under guidance of teachers. During the assembly, students present the news, share a thought and deliver speeches about important days.

Remedial classes and evening classes are conducted for class 10 and class 9. To live harmoniously in the society, students have to develop moral virtues. Moral education is given in the school to instill moral values in student.

### **School Reopening**

The academic year commenced with a Staff Retreat on 30<sup>th</sup> May 2022, led by the school Local Manager Rev. NebuSkariah. Thereafter a staff meeting was held to plan the activities of the school.

The school reopened on 1<sup>st</sup> June 2022 with the blessings and prayers of Rev. NebuSkariah, Local Manager.

Two interactive smart boards were installed. These are being used by the Teachers in enhancing the effectiveness of the teaching-learning process.

Important days like Environment Day, Vayanadhinam, Independence Day etc. were observed in the school, Dr. Harischandran (Retired. Prof Bishop Moore College) was the chief guest for the Reading Day.

### **PTA Meeting**

A PTA meeting was conducted on 2/July/2022 at 10AM. A good number of Parents attended the meeting. Executive members were elected and teacher representatives also were nominated. We have conducted a counseling session for parents on the topic “mindful parenting” by Mr. Ron Mathew Kuruvilla, Rehabilitation Psychologist, St. Gregorious Medical Mission Multi Specialty Hospital Parumala on the same day.

We have an effective and supportive PTA and PTA meetings are conducted periodically. We express our sincere gratitude to Mr. Binu John Varghese, Mr. Binu Varghese serving as PTA President and Vice President respectively. The PTA donated a water cooler and sponsored the mementos for the exceptional achievers.

Onam was celebrated and the chief guest was Rev. M. P Joseph. His wife, Mrs Annamma Daniel and our Well Wisher Mr. Mathew Oommen were also present.

## **Kalotsavam**

To bring out various talents embedded in students, Kalotsavam was conducted for two days. Karatte Grading for students was done in the School.

Independence Day, Children's Day, Teachers Day, Hindi Day, Kerala Day were observed in the school.

Our students attended an exhibition held at S B College, Changanacherry.

## **Tour programme**

A one day tour programme was conducted to Alappuzha for class X students.

## **Counselling**

Counseling empowers students to accomplish mental health, wellness and aim for career goals. Counseling classes were conducted in the school.

Excise Inspector Mr. Arun Kumar gave an awareness class on bad effects of drug usage.

An eminent counselor Mr. Sunil D Kuruvilla, engaged an Enrichment session for students on 04<sup>th</sup> November 2022.

On November 1<sup>st</sup> an anti-narcotic rally to Kodukulanji junction was organized to create public awareness. The students performed a Flash mob and a mimeto give an insight into the harmful effects of drugs.

## **Annual sports Meet**

The Annual Sports Meet was held on 11-Nov-2022. Rev NebuSkariah, Local Manager presided over the Inaugural Function and Sub Inspector of Venmony Police Station Sri Joy Mathai was Chief Guest and Inaugurated the Sports Meet.

## **Children's Day Celebration**

Children's Day was celebrated on 14-Nov-2022. The day was made memorable as some students came dressed as Chaacha Nehru. A Children's Day rally was also conducted and students presented various programmes.

## **Charity**

Rs.3,21,130/- was raised for the treatment of Adam Muhammed of class 2 B who was suffering from Aplastic Anemia and the amount was handed over to his parents.

We arranged a virtual space program called “Become an Astronaut” for the students on 21<sup>st</sup> November 2022.

### **Staff Meeting**

Regular staff meetings are conducted to discuss various operational matters. The teachers were actively involved in preparing the vision and mission statement for the school in addition to identifying the core values. The class X evaluation session brought out the areas requiring more attention and steps are taken towards improving ourselves.

### **Examination**

Unit tests, periodic tests and half yearly exam were conducted as scheduled. Parents were informed about the progress of their wards and open house was also conducted.

### **Governing Council**

The Governing council and the working committee evaluates the functioning of the school and gives necessary guidance and support for the smooth conduct of the school. The governing council has given green signal for installing CCTV, setting up indoor games room, adding more computers and accessories and giving a facelift to the school. Setting up an art room is also in progress. I extend my whole hearted thanks to the governing council and the working committee members.
